Directions from I-84 West. Take Exit #18, bear left at the fork and take a left at the light. Go to second light third light for West Entrance.

Directions from I-84 East. Take exit#18. At light take a right and at next light take a right. Go over bridge and at light take a left onto Chase Parkway. Go to the second light for West Entrance.

Kinney Hall. Take the elevator in area labeled S1 or S2. Take elevator or stairs to Level 5. Take a left from elevator/stairs to Cafeteria West. Entrance is on your left.
